Laura de Girolamo (PhD) is the director of the Orthopaedic Biotechnology Laboratory (OBL) of the Galeazzi Orthopaedic Institute in Milan. She got her post-doctoral training between the Galeazzi Orthopaedic Institute and other international centers, including the Cartilage Repair Center, Boston, MA affiliated with Brigham and Women's Hospital and Harvard Medical School.

She is Chair of the Basic Science Committee of ESSKA and Chair of the Research Committee of SIGASCOT. She was co-founder of the Italian Mesenchymal Stem Cell Group (GISM) and currently member of the Executive Committee.

Her basic and translational research focus is on mesenchymal stem cells, particularly derived from adipose tissue and tendons.
